Software Available on NWTC Sturgeon Bay Library Computers and Remotely through Virtual Desktop

3-D Viewer – 3D Viewer lets users view 3D models and animations with lighting controls, model data and different shading modes.

Access – A database program used to create and manipulate reports using a variety of formats. This tool helps users store information for reference, reporting, and analysis – such as asset tracking, charitable contributions, inventory, time and billing, and more.

Adobe Acrobat – Programs used to view, create, manipulate, print and manage files in Portable Document Format (PDF). The three programs include Distiller XI, XI Pro, and FormsCentral.

Excel – This program is a spreadsheet application designed to perform basic and complex mathematical computations and functions. Excel also allows users to create graphical displays of data, forms, and tables.

Firefox – A web browser (one of the preferred web browsers by NWTC)

Google Chrome – A web browser (the preferred web browser by NWTC)

Internet Explorer – A web browser (not recommended for NWTC applications)

Maps – Users can map multiple locations, get directions, view live traffic conditions as well as satellite, aerial and street side imagery.

Microsoft Edge - A web browser

Microsoft OneDrive – Application that allows user to save and/or share files, photos, and videos.

OneNote 2016 – A computer program that stores and organizes notes, audio, sketches, and pictures. Users can share these notes with others who can view and also contribute.

Outlook – Email, calendar, and contacts

Paint 3D – This program adopts many features found in the original Paint app, but also allows users the ability to make 3D objects.

PowerPoint – Computer program that allows you to create and show slides to support a presentation. Users can combine text, graphics, ad multi-media content.

Project – An application designed to assist project managers in developing plans, assigning tasks, tracking progress, managing budgets, and analyzing workloads.

Publisher – A graphic design program that includes templates for common business needs, such as business cards, brochures, address labels and calendars. Publisher differs from Word in that the emphasis is placed on page layout and design rather than text composition and proofing.

Snip & Sketch – A tool for users to create, annotate, save, and share screenshots.

Sticky Notes – An alternative to OneNote for taking quick notes and reminders that will stay on your desktop.

Video Editor – A program that trim videos, creates movies and slideshows.

Visio – A program used to create diagrams and charts. It offers a variety of built-in shapes, objects, and stencils to work with, or users can make their own and import them.

VMware Horizon Client – A software that establishes a connection between endpoint devices and Horizon View Virtual desktops and applications.

Windows Accessories – An array of tools including character map, notepad, paint, snipping tool, recorder, fax and scan, media player, word pad, and more.

Windows Ease of Access – Various tools to maximize convenience for users including magnifier, narrator, on screen keyboard, and speech recognition.

Word – A word processor that allows users to type and save documents.

Photoshop – A software application used for image editing, photo retouching, and digital painting. Photoshop is a critical tool for designers, web developers, graphic artists, photographers, and creative professionals.

SolidWorks – This program allows users to create 2-D and 3-D model designs.

71800-Pro Tools – A digital audio workstation developed for a wide range of sound recording and sound production purposes. Users can edit, mix, and add sound effects to their recordings.
